Montessori Méditerranée Experience - France

You will experience a powerful week with like-minded Montessorians enjoying breathtaking surrounds in Provence. The 'Montessori Maison', a villa with a private pool and a big terrace, will be waiting for you. This specially prepared environment will provide Montessorians from around the globe the chance to connect, bond and meditate in an enriching and fulfilling environment. A chance for change.

Each morning after breakfast we will focus on one key 'Montessori' word and discuss its meaning. All words, suggested readings and preparation for yourself will be sent to you before the experience starts. Throughout the morning there will be moments of mindfulness and silence. There will be readings, music, creativity, philosophical discussions, reflection, and time for yourself. As we live and work together, we will have many opportunities to share our wisdom, experiences, and thoughts.

A delightful typical French lunch will be shared on the terrace overlooking the mountains followed by the afternoon's program. There will be cooking, dancing, and learning French. We will visit St Tropez as well as small villages and wineries. There will be time to swim, relax, and reflect.

Montessori's Roma Experience - Italy

After our time in France, we meet again in Rome for the uniquely Italian experience of exploring some of Maria Montessori's life story. Tools to explore and discover the places significant to her formation will be provided.

While in Rome, we will be in a 'Prepared Environment' for adults; - an experiential classroom where our guide will facilitate your explorations. Together, we will be constructing a historical perspective on Maria Montessori's work through listening to presentations, hands-on activities, 3-hour work periods, unstructured time and ample opportunity to reflect and share.

This is a special opportunity to learn about the environment that influenced Maria Montessori's growth and development between 1875, when she first arrived in Rome, until 1951 when she gave her final courses in the Eternal City.

Your Guide

Karin Slabaugh will be our guide as we walk 'Maria Montessori's Roma'. Karin, originally from the United States, has been in Italy for over ten years researching the Montessori 0-3 history. She offers courses and retreats through a not-for-profit organization, Montessori-For-Life.org following the work of Grazia Honegger Fresco. Grazia studied directly under Maria Montessori and Adele Costa Gnocchi and was one of the founders of 0-3 Montessori. As well as offering courses on the newborn and the first two years of life, Karin has been developing workshops for the Montessori approach to working with elderly people who have memory decline and students with special needs.
